- 3 **Performance:** Maximum 6 per student
- 4 **Display:** Maximum 6 per student

NOTE: Maximum 18 events per student.
*Choir, Basketball & Volleyball are excluded from entry limits.

During Fall & Winter

1. Use the Student Events Worksheet to plan your entries, then turn in the form to your school coordinator by _____.
2. Carefully read the General Guidelines for Student Convention and also the specific guidelines for all your entries.
3. Work with your school coordinator to find sponsors to help you with your projects if needed.
4. Begin work on your entries.

By February 28

1. Register for your events under the supervision of your school coordinator.
2. Check with your parents to make sure they have filled out the Parent Permission Form.

By March 25

1. Submit Early Entries (categories judged prior to convention), under the supervision of your school coordinator.
2. Submit all required materials for performance and display entries, under the supervision of your school coordinator.
