

(231-232) Cake Decorating

Before submitting an art entry, students should read this section and review opening sections of these Guidelines--paying careful attention to the sections entitled Judging, Appearance, Attendance, and Conduct.

To enter, students must select this event on the CF3 Registration Form, pay the required Student Entry Fee, and submit the project information online by April 15th.

PACKING: All contestants are responsible for the packaging, transporting and proper handling of their competition entries.

DELIVERY: All items must be brought to the Convention Wednesday morning and removed from the premises by Saturday morning.

DISPLAY: Entries must have a display card securely attached to the project with the following information neatly printed or typed: event, student's name, school name. Display card must be clearly visible.

WCA STUDENT CONVENTION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRIES LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED.

RULES

1. Entries in Cake Decorating must be entirely edible.
2. No entry should exceed two feet in any direction.
3. Entries must arrive in satisfactory exhibition condition.
4. A brief explanation of the entire creation process should be included so that the judges can understand the time and level of difficulty involved in producing the cake.

Judges will consider the selection of the piece, colors chosen, techniques used and overall appearance of the cake. Cakes using fondant will be judged separately as this is a completely different technique.
