

(221-222) Woodworking

PACKING: All contestants are responsible for the packaging, transporting and proper handling of their competition entries. No entry may exceed 40 pounds in weight or exceed more than two or three feet in its longest dimension (depending on the category entered.)

DELIVERY: All items must be brought to the Convention Wednesday morning and removed from the premises by Saturday morning.

DISPLAY: Entries must have a display card securely attached to the project with the following information neatly printed or typed: event, student's name, school name. Display card must be clearly visible.

WCA STUDENT CONVENTION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRIES LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED.

Woodworking entries are in two categories: Woodworking, Power Tools and Woodworking, Hand Tools. Entries in this category must be made ENTIRELY OF WOOD, except for screws and hinges.

Contestants may use power tools and hand tools for the Woodworking, Power Tools category. Contestant may use *only* hand tools to shape and finish the entry if entered in the Woodworking, Hand Tools category.

Wood items may not exceed three feet in any direction. Craft items such as miniature toys, models, or picture frames are not acceptable.
