(223) Metalworking

PACKING: All contestants are responsible for the packaging, transporting and proper handling of their competition entries. No entry may exceed 40 pounds in weight or exceed more than two or three feet in its longest dimension (depending on the category entered.)

DELIVERY: All items must be brought to the Convention Wednesday morning and removed from the premises by Saturday morning.

DISPLAY: Entries must have a display card securely attached to the project with the following information neatly printed or typed: event, student's name, school name. Display card must be clearly visible.

WCA STUDENT CONVENTION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRIES LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED.

Entries in this category must be made of METAL ONLY. Items may be made from any type of metal.

The student may use any type of power tools needed (nippers, welders, grinders, lathes, etc.) to form the pieces of metal that will be used to create the project.

Craft items such as book ends, belt buckles, pen holders, etc., are not acceptable. Weapons are not acceptable (i.e., knives, swords, maces, axes, guns, etc.).
